History and Purpose of ACEA

The Academic Council for Education Accountability (ACEA) was founded in June 1998, out of a desire for Christian institutions related to various Apostolic Networks to meet together on a peer level, and to build relationships. At the first meeting, 100 educators from 65 base institutions met together. The essential challenges discussed were:

ACEA is not a new form of
Accreditation, but rather a creative
Alternative to academic accreditation.

Institutions can receive the desired
ongoing peer-level evaluation
and mutual accountability while
maintaining the integrity of their
individual callings from God.

ACEA was founded by C. Peter Wagner who convened the Apostolic Leaders
From 12 states as well as Canada and Asia.
Since 1998, we meet regularly to ensure that ACEA is addressing the most current issues and meeting the needs of the members. Over 70 institutions are active members.

Membership

Any institution engaged in training individuals for Christian ministry.

Annual fee is \$440 U.S. Funds

One or more individuals representing the school must attend the annual meeting in November.

The annual meeting registration is \$95 per person or \$145 per married couple, and is combined with the International Coalition of Apostolic Leaders Summit each November.
